These are the lecture notes that go with the lantern slides (which have been put into alphabetical order). The notes include photographs and newspaper cuttings. At the end of lecture 1 are 1 newspaper cuttings describing the lecture given at various venues from 14th February 1913 to 1926. List of societies where lectures were given. Mr Hepworth was still alive in October 1926 but had died by 1944 according to a letter in lecture 3 records. Location given in square brackets: NY North Yorkshire, WY West Yorkshire, EY East Yorkshire.

ANCIENT HOMES OF YORKSHIRE. - A lantern lecture promoted by the photographic section of the Literary and Scientific Society, with Mr. George Hepworth (Brighouse) member of the Yorkshire Photographic Union, as the lecturer, was much enjoyed last Saturday night in the secondary Schools. Mr. Hepworth spoke in interesting style of many old houses in the county, rich in traditions, legendary lore, and historical associations. The houses at Newburgh, Kirklees, Kildwick, Farnhill, Markenfield, Norton Conyers, Weston, Burton Constable, and Shibden were among a most interesting series, illustrated by beautiful views produced from photographs taken by Mr. Hepworth; some of these exhibited details of interiors, testifying eloquently to the skill of the photographer, and arousing the admiration of the photographers who were present. The lecture proved a treat as the Chairman (Mr. S. Greenwood) had anticipated, and the appreciation of the audience was expressed in a hearty vote of thanks moved by Mr. J. Bamford. Mr. E. B. Gibson, L.D.S., had charge of the lantern.
